

Harvest Declaration

N.B. Growers who are also wine producers should use a Production Declaration (WSB 21) in place of this form.

IMPORTANT

Under the Common Agricultural Policy (Wine) Regulations it is a statutory requirement that all growers make annual Harvest Declarations to the Wine Standards Board.

For the purpose of this declaration:

- “growers” are natural or legal persons who cultivate and harvest vines;
- in Section 2, the figure stated for the **Total Area** in production has been taken from the Vineyard Register. This is based on the area under cultivated vines in production (vines under three years old are excluded). **If the area stated is incorrect, please amend it.**

All growers are required to complete the Declaration unless:

- the **total** grape harvest is intended for table grapes or for drying or for processing directly into grape juice; **or**
- the **total** area is less than 10 acres ($\frac{1}{4}$ acre) **and** the harvest will not be marketed in any form whatsoever.

- This form has been printed in a set of 3 on self copy paper.
- When the form has been completed you should send copies 1 and 2 together with copies 1 and 2 of any continuation sheets (WSB 12A) to your local Wine Standards Board inspector at the address indicated on the front cover, in the envelope provided. The third copy should be retained for your records.
- If you need to use the continuation sheets (WSB 12A), please make sure you attach copies 1 and 2 securely to WSB 12.
- Your local inspector may visit your premises to check the accuracy of the information given.
- Where grapes are sold for uses other than winemaking (i.e. for the making of grape juice) details should be entered in Section 5 of the form.

IMPORTANT: Completed form(s) must reach the local Wine Standards Board inspector no later than 10 December.
